1) What is 'Tadoku'?

'Ta' in Tadoku means 'a lot', and 'doku' means 'to read' in Japanese.

You simply start reading a lot of easy books that you can really enjoy.

Easy books are fun to read. \rightarrow You enjoy reading so you read more. \rightarrow You go on to the higher level step by step.

Tadoku also helps to improve your speaking, listening and writing skills. Eventually you will get to understand Japanese without translating.

2) Four Golden Rules of 'Tadoku'

- **DStart from scratch**
- **2Do not use your dictionary**
- 3Skip over difficult words and phrases
- When reading gets tough, quit the book and pick up another
