Minami-Ward will have the 70th anniversary of its municipality on December 1, 2013. During the World War II, in 1943 (the 18th year of the Showa Era), Minami Ward was separated from Naka Ward. From then until now, Minami Ward has recovered from the devastation of the war and gone through high economic growth and developed dramatically while the Showa Era changed to the Heisei Era.

Minami Ward is pleased to celebrate this special year, therefore, it is planning to hold some special events for its further development for the future.

As one of the events, the 'Great Photo Exhibition' is scheduled to be held in three places sequentially from October until December 2013.
