New school year starts in April in Japan Elementary (Primary) School

- ★ School year begins in April. Pupils spend six years at elementary schools; no repeating of grades in general. There are class observations for parents/guardians; four or five times a year.
- ★ No provided meals on such days as a field day, excursions, etc. Parents/guardians will prepare a packed lunch for their children. No special arrangements are necessary. No matter if you get one from a store. In that case, it may be a good idea to replace it into your lunch box.
- ★Interpreters are available when you meet a teacher at private consultation or home visit. Please ask school staff.
- ★Don't forget to take your slippers when you visit school. No slippers are provided for parents/quardians.

Middle (Junior High) School

- ★No repeating of grades in Japanese middle schools, even though your performance is not good. You will move up to the next grade in April.
- ★ School performance is very important! Records of latter half of the second year and first half of the third year will be sent to the senior high school when you take its entrance examination.
- ★98 percent of middle school students go on to senior high schools. You have to pass the entrance exam of a senior high. Some schools prepare special exams for foreign students. Some schools positively accept foreigners.
- ★ Daily attitude at school is important! No absence from school. Not to be late for school. Do your homework every day. Submit all works (notebooks, papers).

 - . Finished foreign middle school before coming to Japan, and wishing to enter Japanese senior high school.

 - iii. Studying at night class of middle school, and wishing to enter senior high school.
 - iv. Anyone who wishes to study at "Tabunka Furii School Yokohama.

- 6. Briefings: 1st: 6 Apr 2014 (Sun), from 1400 hours 2nd: 22 Apr 2014 (Tue), from 1700 hours

24th Minami Ward Cherry Blossom Festival


Lighting up of cherry blossoms along the O-oka Gawa River And many other enjoyable events!

Legislation to be enforced on 1 April 2014:

☆Consumption tax rate will be raised to 8 % on 1 April 2014.

It will be raised again to 10 %, in one and a half years time, on 1 October 2015.

☆Japanese government will join the Hague Convention on the Civil Aspects of International Child Abduction.

The premium of National Pension will be raised by 210 yen per month from 15,040 yen in JFY 2013 to 15,250 yen.
