- 1. Curriculum: Study subjects for entering senior high schools (Japanese/Kokugo, mathematics & English)
- 2. Who can enroll the class?
 - i. Finished foreign middle school before coming to Japan, and wishes to enter Japanese high school.
 - ii. Finished Japanese middle school, and preparing for entering high school.
 - iii. Studying at night class of middle school, and wishes to enter high school.
 - iv. Anyone who wishes to study at "Tabunka Free School Yokohama."
- 3. Location: At the Minami Lounge, etc, in the Yokohama Municipal Urafune Welfare Complex building.
