### School Guidance Viewed By the Elementary School Principal

The school guidance means an orientation lecture, in three languages, namely, Chinese, English and Japanese, by the Minami Lounge for foreign related parents and guardians of the children who are to enroll public elementary and middle schools in Minami ward.

We interviewed Mr. Fujimoto, the head teacher of Minami Yoshida elementary school. In his school, more than 50 per cent of the pupils are foreigners or foreign related ones. Various actions, therefore, are taken by the school for the children to experience the cultures of others. During "the greeting week", they greet each other by saying "good morning" in many languages. They enjoy world cuisine at "MY World Lunch", and learn food cultures and characteristics vary in the world. At the "Relation Hours",

they enjoy games of other peoples. And more.

Flows of foreigners never stop to this school where already many pupils with different cultures and customs are studying. We asked the principal whether there had been any changes since the school guidance started in April.

Fujimoto replied that, after the guidance, the guardians became conscious about themselves as guardians whose children were attending new school. As the lecture gave them in advance concerning an idea of the school life in Japan, they see the difference from their original countries.

"I am happy, as a head of a school, that the parents now understand that they have to make efforts to get used to the school life, as well as their children do. Although it is not a simple matter to understand different cultures and tolerate each other, we can do it working with the families, school and communities." "My dream," he continues, "is that the children studied at Minami Yoshida will love each country and love each culture of the world, and dispatch the good points of, not only Minami Yoshida but also Yokohama, to the world."

It is impossible to learn all the school system by only one lecture. He hopes to have a second guidance after children started the school live, so that we can obtain questions from the guardians and take following up actions.
